



PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

Participants of the Open House WWI Dawn Patrol Rendezvous, held at the National Museum of the United States Air Force (NMUSAF) are subject to all rules and regulations as outlined by the NMUSAF. I understand that this agreement is a NMUSAF agreement, governed by the laws of the Federal Government.

As a participant, I shall comply with all applicable safety and security guidelines and Federal laws and regulations and with all applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of the state, county, and municipality wherein the premises are located. I agree to attend participant briefings as required and will provide all requested and required information and documentation and understand that failure to do so could result in cancellation of participation.

I shall not discriminate against any person or persons or exclude any persons from participation in the event's operations, programs, or activities conducted on the participant's premises, because of race, color, age, sex, handicap, national origin or religion.

I shall not store, release or discharge any hazardous substances, hazardous constituents, or petroleum, including crude oil or any fraction thereof, on the premises nor shall the participant otherwise conduct any activities in, at, on, or around the premises in any manner which would cause any air, water (including ground water), soil or real property facility contamination, or solid or hazardous waste pollution, or become a public nuisance.

I give permission, without any restrictions, to the NMUSAF or its partners, to use still and motion pictures and sound recordings of me, my aircraft, equipment, crew members, employees and agents for news, advertising, promotional media and commercial uses.

I understand that the event coordinators may, at any time and at its sole discretion cancel any or all of the NMUSAF Open House WWI Dawn Patrol Rendezvous, and at any time and at its sole discretion, may cancel my participation.

I agree that I will hold the United States, its agencies, officers, employees, agents, and contractors harmless, indemnify, and defend them against any and all suits, actions, and claims of any kind whatsoever, including attorney fees and costs, which may arise from or be the result of my participation in this event.
